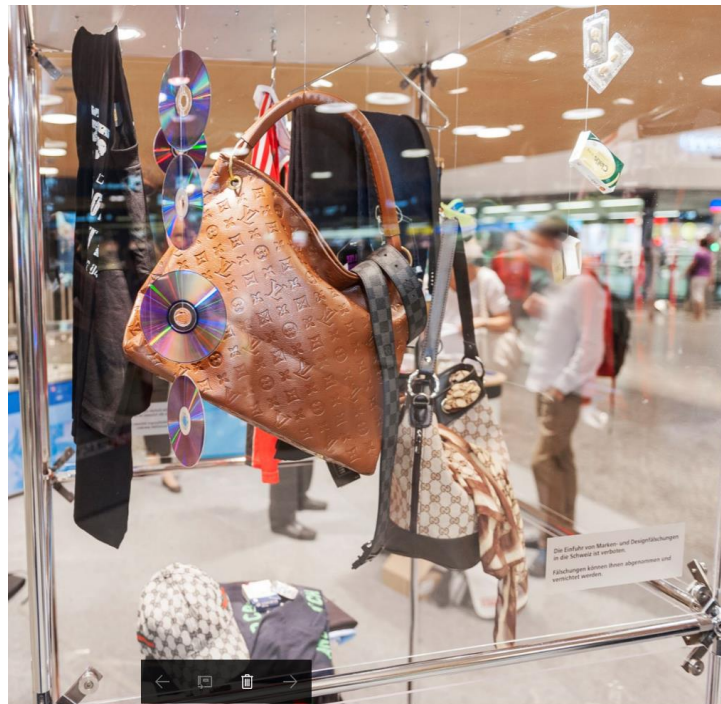
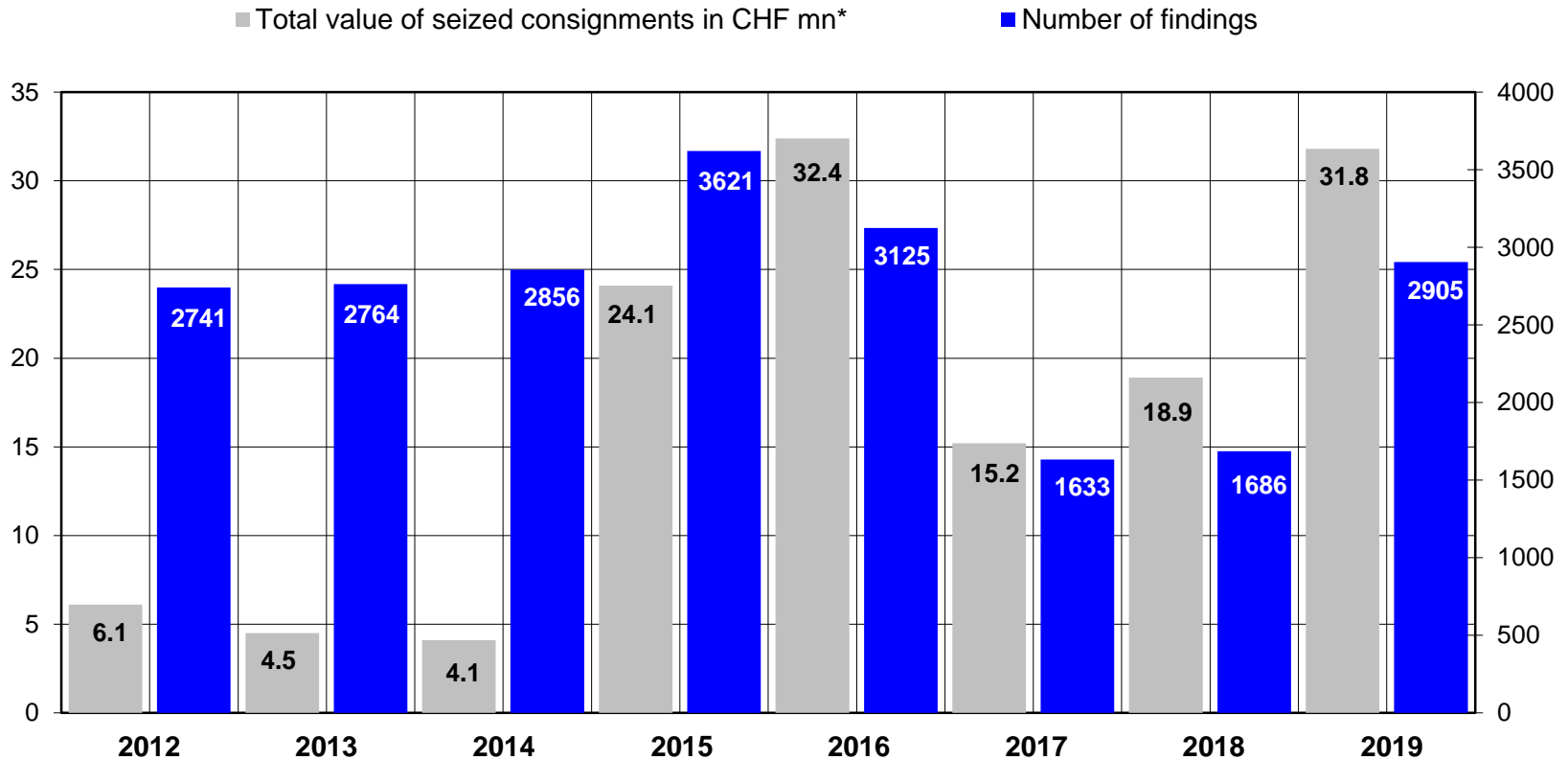

I. Commercial import, export and transit (incl. mail and courier consignments)

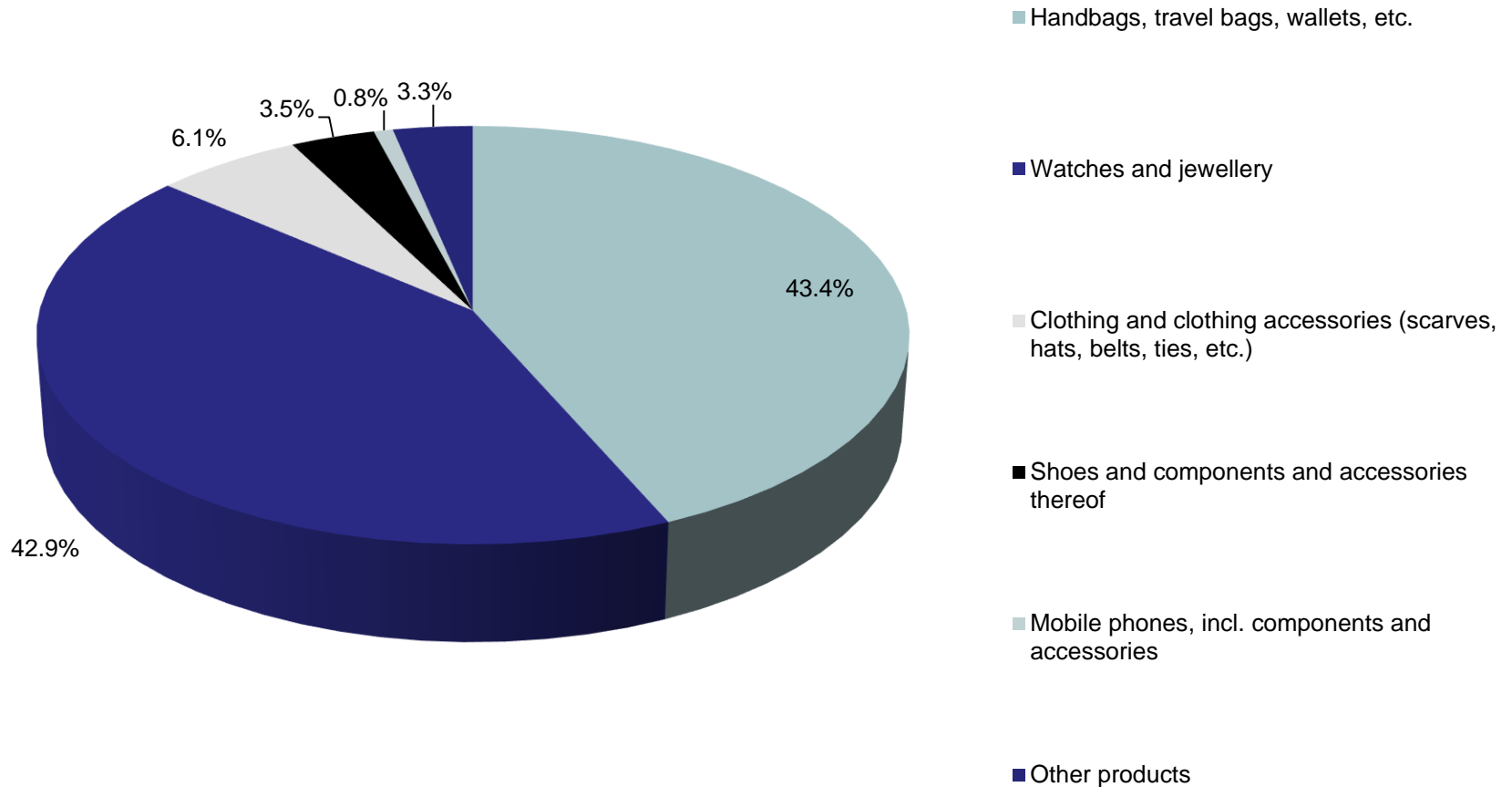


*Values match those of the comparable original articles; not included are 7781 drugs consignments, which were seized due to the Therapeutic Products Act.

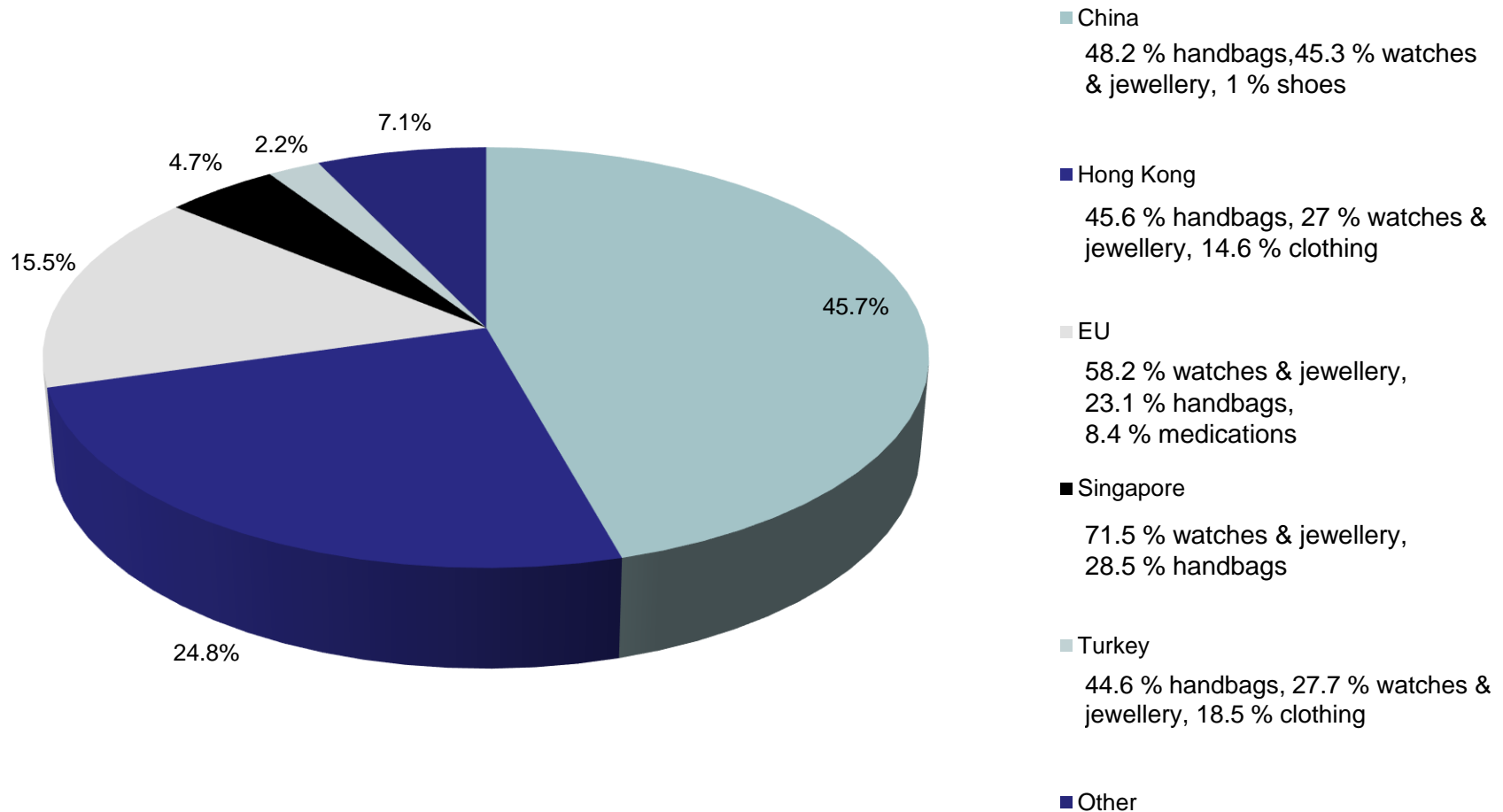
Findings by categories of goods (commercial)





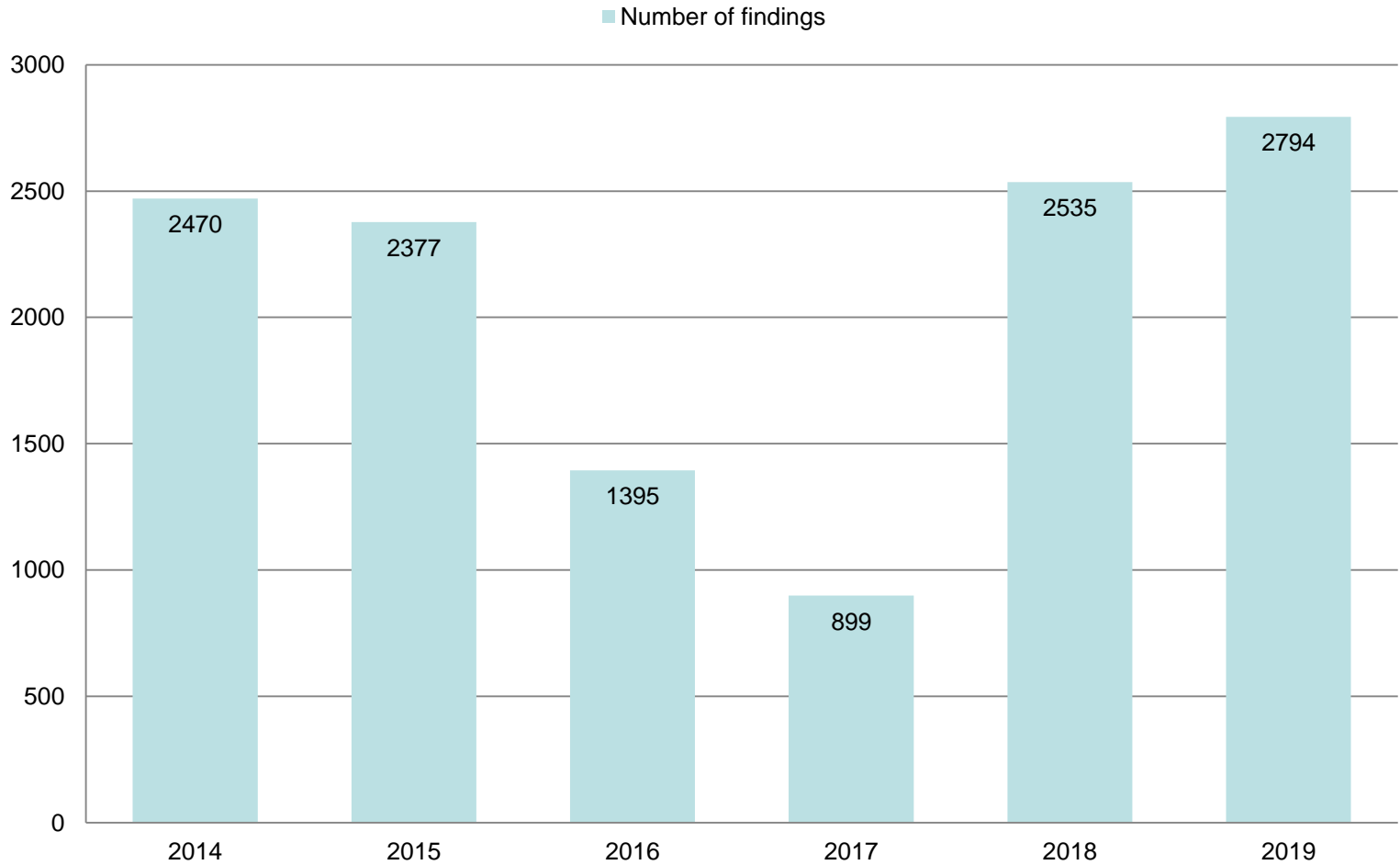

Origin of counterfeits (commercial)





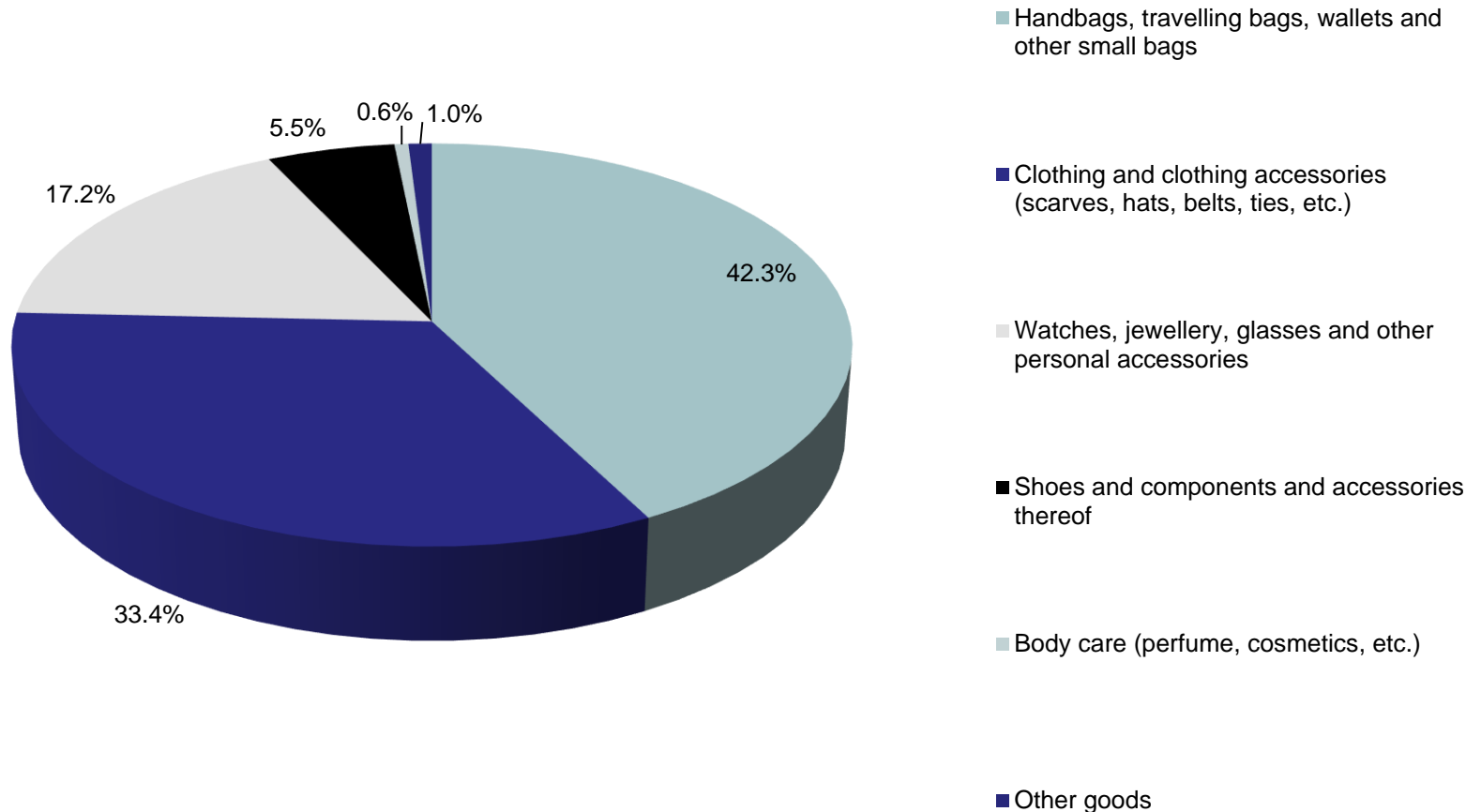

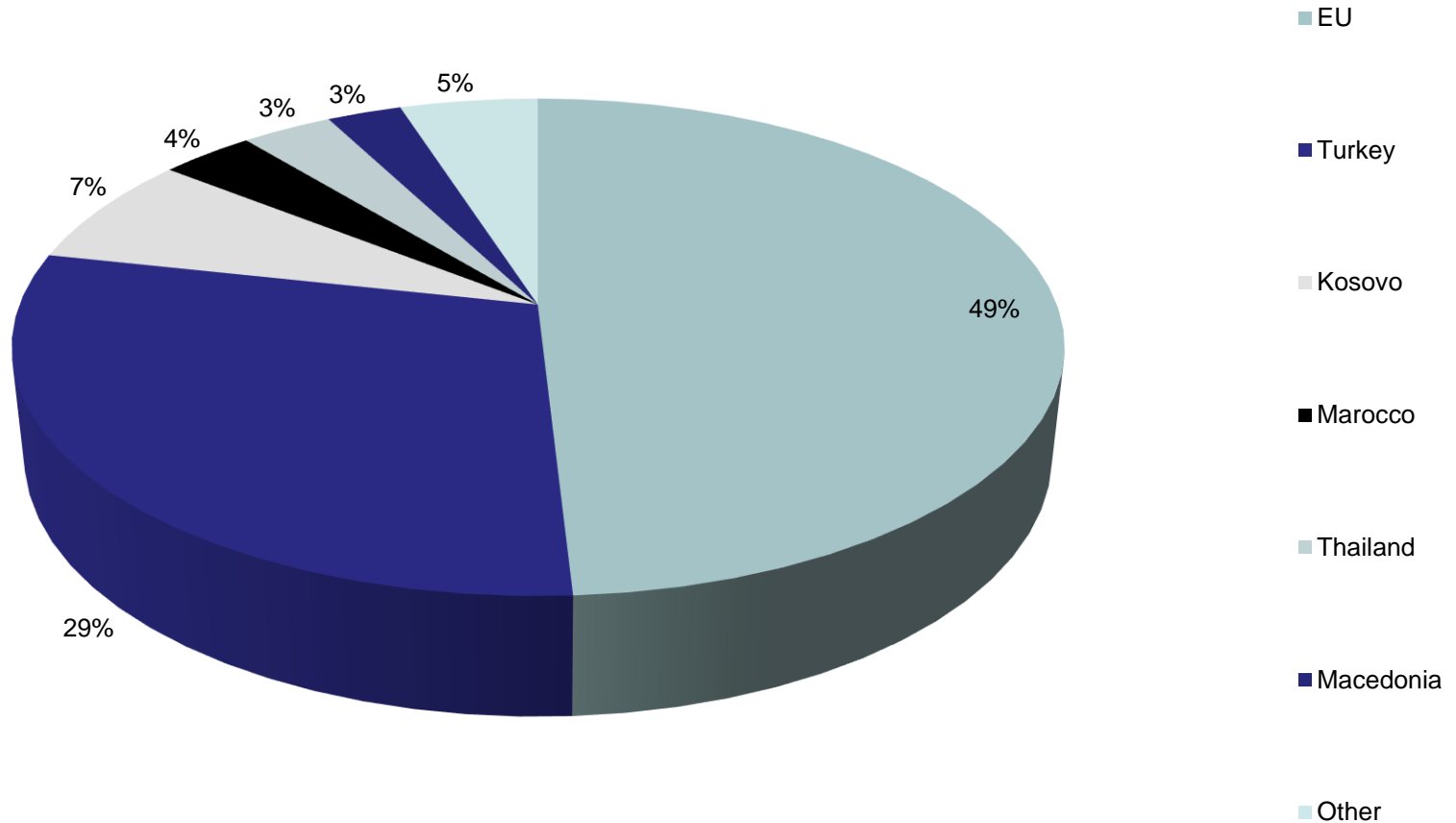
Findings by categories of goods (tourist traffic)
